



Chu Jingli: male, born in November 1962. In July 1985, he graduated from the Library Science Department of Northeast Normal University and received a bachelor's degree. In February 1988, he graduated from Library and Information Science Department of Peking University and received a master's degree. In July 2003, he graduated from the Graduate School of Chinese Academy of Sciences and received a doctor's degree. In 2004, from April to September, he was invited to Seton Hall University Library as a senior visiting scholar. From February 1988 to January 2002, he taught in the Department of Information Management of Liaoning Normal University. Since January 2002, he subsequently served as the director of the Education and Research Development Department of National Science Library of Chinese Academy of Sciences (NSLCAS), director of the Subject Consulting Service Department of NSLCAS and director of the Editorial and Publishing Center of NSLCAS. Now, Professor Chu Jingli is the director of the Scientific Journal Research and Training Center of NSLCAS. He serves as the president of the magazine office of Library and Information Service and its chief editor. He is also the chief editor of Knowledge Management Forum, the executive deputy chief editor of Think Tank: Theory & Practice, the managing deputy chief editor of Chinese Journal of Scientific and Technical Periodicals and the standing vice secretary-general of STM Journals Society of Chinese Academy of Sciences. He is a doctoral supervisor and postdoctoral co-supervisor. He is also a second-grade research librarian, an evaluation expert of National Social Science Foundation Disciplinary Planning, deputy director of Specialized Committee of the User Research and Service of Library Society of China, standing committee member of Specialized Committee of Information Literacy. Besides, he is the member of the editorial boards of Journal of Academic Libraries, Library Development, Digital Library Forum, Library and Information Science, part-time professor of Northeast Normal University, guest professor of South China Normal University.

He has studied, practiced and taught in the field of library and information science development strategies, users' services, the subject service and scientific journals' editing and publishing for years. He subsequently hosted National Social Science Foundation Project: *the Theory of Compound Library and the Construction of Compound Libraries in China*, *Research on the Theory and Method of Embedded Subject Service in Libraries*, National Social Science Foundation Key Project *Research on the Influence of New Types of Publishing Modes on Academic Libraries*. Furthermore, he hosted *the Report of Scientific Periodicals Development of China Association for Science and Technology* and many researches on the policy and planning of scientific periodicals. He has published five books. His representative works include *Research on Digital Reference Service*, Beijing Library Press, 2004; *the Theory and Method of Compound Libraries* (first author), Shanghai Jiaotong University Press, 2009; *Library Development Reform and Service Transformation*, National Library Press, 2012; *The Theory and Method of Embedded Subject Service in Libraries* (co-editor-in-chief), Science Press, 2015. He has published over 150 papers on academic journals at home and abroad.
